_____ If I have to be absent from a rehearsal, I will notify Mrs. Dimas by phone or email BEFORE the rehearsal that I will miss. I understand that excessive or unexcused absences may prohibit me from performing in the final concert.

_____ I will be on time. Singing will start promptly at 6:30 PM. I will be in my place with my music and materials at the beginning of every rehearsal.
