How do I join?

-Interested students should contact their school choir/general music teacher. Then you simply audition/apply with your music teacher at your school! Your teacher can share audition specifics, dates, and times with you.

-What happens if I make it?

When you are selected as a member of the choir, you receive a packet of information and a form to return to your music teacher. Music will be provided. Then you participate in rehearsals and the culminating concert performance!

-Does it cost anything?

Yes. To participate in the Elementary Honors Choir you must pay the required fee of \$15.00. This will cover the cost of the administrative needs of the program. (Checks will be payable to the Chantilly High School Music Boosters). Scholarship is available with a written application for dire financial needs.

-Students will be in an advanced honors chorus and will sing fun and challenging music!!!

-Honors Choir is a program available as an extra curricular program, and is an expanded experience to your regular school day and classroom music program.

-Rehearsals will take place in The **Choral Room (105) at Chantilly High School**. Adult supervision will be provided and there will be high school student assistance along the way as well.

-Selected students will need to commit to attendance at all performances and rehearsals. Being chosen is a privilege and we do have specific performance goals! More details to follow in your acceptance packet.

-Rehearsals will be on Thursdays, 6:30 – 8:00 PM.
