PARENTS:

Setting up chairs, organizing equipment, assisting with administrative tasks all help make the process run smoothly. *Please select a date (or dates) when you can be available to chaperone a rehearsal and complete the student information forms.* We will contact volunteers and post a volunteer schedule on the Honors Choir web page as soon as the list is organized and becomes available.
2. We will need up to four parents that will be our concert event managers. These parents will assist with the preparations and supervision of the students on the day of the concert performance. Duties and responsibilities will be defined by the directors as the event draws close. Once the program begins you can contact the director directly regarding these responsibilities.
3. If you are able to donate a case of mini water bottles, or a couple boxes of facial tissues, or a box of number two pencils, your gift would be well used and a valuable resource in our rehearsal setting.
4. Encourage and monitor your child's individual practice. Help them organize materials and assist them in their preparation for their success.
5. Attend the concert event and praise their achievement. Your presence and encouragement is the greatest gift you can give your child in support of this program.
